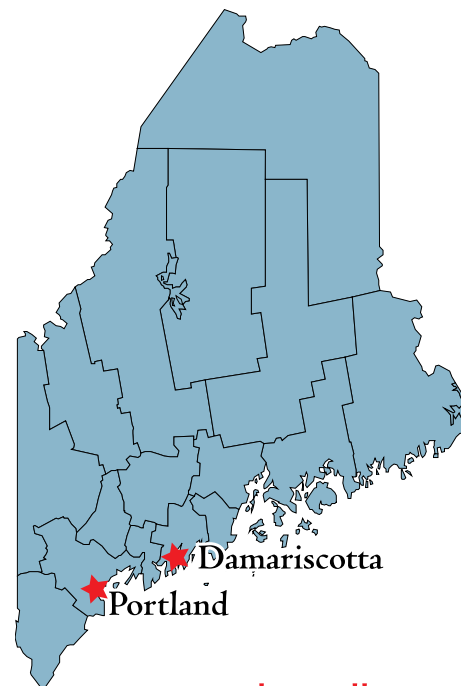

BY CAR:

- Take I-95 North to NH/Maine (also called the Maine Turnpike) Portions toll
- Merge on to I-295 North – Exit 44, South Portland, Downtown Portland
- Exit Route 28, US 1/Coastal Route/Brunswick/Bath
- Exit US Business Route 1 to Route 129/130 which turns into Main Street, Damariscotta

BY BUS:

Concord Bus Lines provides daily travel from Boston Logan Airport and Portland to Bath, Wiscasset, Damariscotta, Waldoboro and Rockland.

BY TRAIN:

Take the Amtrak Downeaster from Boston North Station to Brunswick. In Brunswick connect with the Maine Eastern Railway weekend service from Brunswick to Rockland with stops in Bath, Wiscasset, and Newcastle-Damariscotta from July 30 through Oct 25 (except Sept)

ALNA was first settled in 1663. In 1794, it was incorporated as the town of New Milford. In 1811, however, finding the name “too industrial,” residents changed it to Alna (Latin for “alder trees” which proliferated in the town). The Alna Meeting House (1789) is a rare example of an 18th-century church, with its high pulpit and box pews unchanged for more than two centuries.

Boothbay Center

BOOTHBAY HARBOR incorporated on February 16, 1889 from land set off from the town of Boothbay. It is a major attraction for summer visitors with its shops, restaurants, art galleries, marinas, and recreational fishing opportunities. Tours to coastal islands, whale watching, and a safe and engaging harbor for sailors are some of the attractions for summer visitors.

DAMARISCOTTA The historic coastal village of Damariscotta, once a famous shipbuilding town, overlooks a tidal river, the Damariscotta, and is the peninsula's year-round commercial center, with shops, galleries, and restaurants. It's home to several historic landmarks, arts organizations and community land trusts — all dedicated to preserving the area's rich cultural and natural heritage.

BOOTHBAY incorporated on November 3, 1764. In 1842 it set off land to form Townsend, later to become Southport in 1850. It includes Damariscove Island, an early fishing outpost for Europeans. The Boothbay Region is a center of summer tourist activity.

EDGECOMB On rolling hills between the Sheepscot and Damariscotta Rivers, it is home to Fort Edgecomb, now a state park, built in 1809 on the Sheepscot to protect Wiscasset and its shipping from possible British attack. A block house with parade grounds and remains of fortifications offer a beautiful view of the Narrow, Westport Island, and the Edgecomb shore.

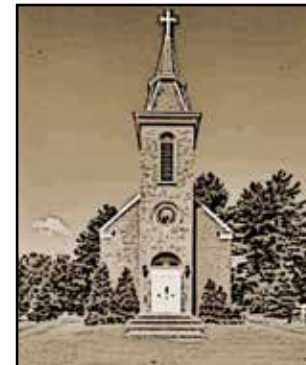


JEFFERSON Rural Jefferson lines the northern and northwestern shores of Damariscotta Lake and includes Damariscotta Lake State Park, known for its fine-sand beach and good bass and togue fishing. This peaceful town offers many lovely views of the lake, especially at its first town house, built in 1835, on the Bunker Hill Road. Jefferson also encompasses a number of fresh-water ponds.

MONHEGAN ISLAND The small rocky island of Monhegan, 10 miles offshore, is home for people who make their living fishing and lobstering, and a summer haven for artists and other visitors seeking quiet relaxation and natural beauty. Access is by boat. Monhegan has no cars or paved roads. Miles of walking trails lead through this rugged, undeveloped landscape of woods and high ocean cliffs.

St. Patrick's Catholic Church

NEWCASTLE lies between two rivers, the Sheepscot and the Damariscotta, and includes the Sheepscot Historic District, which was settled in the 1620s. By 1800, Newcastle was a large and thriving ship-building town. Lincoln Academy, the region's high school, was built in 1801. St. Patrick's Catholic Church, completed in 1808, is the oldest Catholic Church in New England.

NOBLEBORO First settled in the 1720s, Nobleboro calls itself “the little town with a big heart.” A monument on the town common honors Lt. Col. Arthur Noble, who commanded a regiment that included many Maine men at the 1745 capture of Fort Louisburg on Cape Breton Island. Noble’s son led the effort to have the town incorporated, which occurred in 1788.



SOMERVILLE incorporated on March 25, 1858 from Patricktown Plantation. The plantation had existed at least since 1813. On April 17, 1937, in the depth of the Depression, the town surrendered its organization. It returned to its status as a town on February 6, 1974. Somerville is east of Windsor on Route 105, and north of Jefferson following Route 206 to 105. This rural town has had a small, relatively stable population since the mini-boom of the 1970’s.

SOUTH BRISTOL, bordered by the Damariscotta River on the west and Johns Bay on the east, is a center for the traditional maritime trades of lobstering, fishing, and clamming. Mussels and oysters are cultivated in the river; fishing boats anchor in “The Gut” separating South Bristol from Rutherford Island. South Bristol’s Thompson Ice House appears on the National Register of Historic Places.

SOUTHPORT is an island town in Lincoln County, incorporated on February 12, 1842 from a portion of the town of Boothbay. Born under the name of Townsend, it changed to Southport on June 12, 1850. It is connected by a bridge to Boothbay and the casual visitor might not assume the town was on an island. Squirrel Island is a self-governing village corporation within the town. No automobiles are allowed, though residents may use small carts to deliver groceries to their cottages along well kept walkways.

Old German Church, Waldoboro

WALDOBORO, on the banks of the Medomak, is named for General Samuel Waldo, a settler of German descent whose land grant in the early 1700s included much of the current town. Waldoboro became a shipbuilding community where, in 1888, the east coast’s first five-masted schooner was built. Waldoboro was largely settled by Germans; the German Meeting House, c. 1772, is their enduring monument.

WESTPORT ISLAND is an island town in Lincoln County, incorporated on February 5, 1828 from the western portion of the town of Edgecomb, thus Westport. The narrow ten mile long island, once known as Jeremisquam, was sold by the Sagamore Robinhood to John Richards in 1649. By act of the legislature the town of Westport was formed in Feb. 1828.



WHITEFIELD The three villages of quiet, pastoral Whitefield — King’s Mills, Whitefield, and Coopers Mill — are linked by the gentle Sheepscot River, which meanders through the town. It is named for celebrated British evangelist George Whitefield, who inspired colonists before they settled the town in 1770. Today, Whitefield’s population is a cooperative mix of farmers, artists, woodsmen, and other professionals.

WISCASSET, settled in the early 1700s, has one of the deepest harbors in Maine, though it is 14 miles from the sea. It became a great shipbuilding and lumber center, home port to square-rigged ships carrying cargo around the world. Today it boasts fine 18th- and 19th - century homes, historic buildings, museums, and the Maine Art Gallery, along with antique shops, boutiques, and restaurants.

WOOLWICH was first settled in 1638 as Nequasset on land purchased from the Great Chief Mowhotiwormet, commonly known as Chief Robinhood. In 1759, the plantation was set off and incorporated by the Massachusetts General Court, named after Woolwich, England. It is situated on the east side of the Kennebec River, approximately 12 miles from the Atlantic Ocean, with Merrymeeting Bay to the northwest, the confluence of five rivers.
