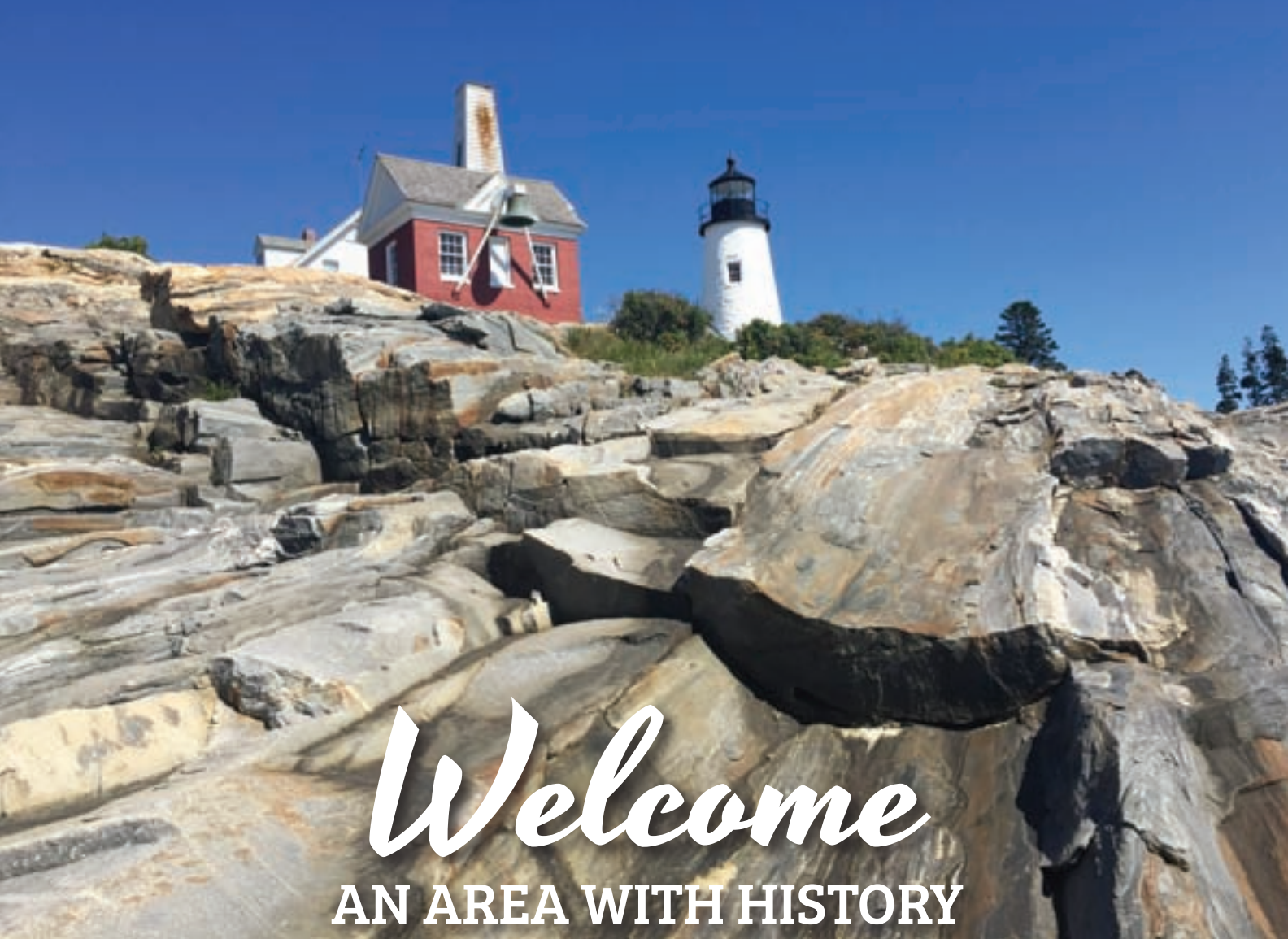

Welcome

AN AREA WITH HISTORY

The Damariscotta-Newcastle region has a rich history that includes all of the chapters you'd expect, boatbuilding, military history and a maritime culture that reads like a novel. The Midcoast's Twin Villages of Damariscotta/Damariscotta Mills and Newcastle are uniquely positioned along the banks of the Damariscotta River, which once hosted a variety of boatbuilding operations beginning in the mid 1700's. As the greatest tall white pines of Maine were reserved by King George of England for the Royal Navy's ship masts, an industry began which included not only boatbuilding, but sawmills, lumberyards, blacksmith and rigging shops. Schooners, brigs and sailing ships were built for New England merchants and were widely acclaimed for their speed and strength. The area produced more

vessels than any other state in the nation at that time, and were sailed around the world.

History buffs will feel right at home in the area, and have a number of sites to explore that reach back for hundreds of years.

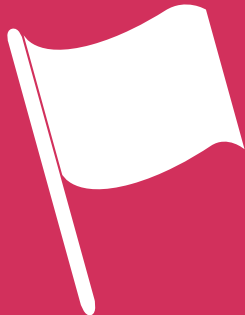
The Pemaquid Point Lighthouse is its own piece of history at the end of the peninsula. Located on the west side of the entrance to Muscongus Bay, its pyramidal tower stands 79 feet above sea level with a light that is visible for 14 nautical miles. Built in 1835 and automated in 1934, the Lighthouse received its first fourth-order Fresnel lens in 1956. The lighthouse was the first in Maine to be automated, rather

than being hosted by a keeper in 1934.

History buffs will feel right at home in the area, and have a number of sites to explore that reach back for hundreds of years. Some notable sites include the **Colonial Pemaquid State Historic Site**, which consists of seventeenth-century **Fort William Henry** and eighteenth-century **Fort Frederick**. Fort William Henry was the largest of its kind in New England when originally built in 1692 by the Colony of Massachusetts. The original structure was destroyed in 1696 by New France in the Siege of Pemaquid and was reconstructed in 1908. Other sites to see include the **Fort Edgecomb Historic** site in Edgecomb and the **Thompson Ice House** located in South Bristol.

YEAR ROUND FUN



From pumpkins and oysters to Christmas lights and ice harvests, each season brings a new slate of offerings to both residents and visitors of the Damariscotta Region! In addition to our Calendar of Events (page 40) with the seasonal schedule of happenings in the area, be sure to look into some of these off-season goings-on:

The traditional ice harvest at the Thompson Ice House in South Bristol is a fun-filled event for all ages. The free event attracts large crowds every February to participate or watch as a crew of volunteers cut large blocks of ice from Thompson Pond using antique tools. The ice harvested during the event is later used to make ice cream for the Thompson Ice House Preservation Corp.'s annual ice cream social, which takes place in July.

The Wiscasset, Waterville & Farmington Railway Museum in Alna offers a fall festival filled with family favorites, including a pumpkin patch, children's games, live music, and hayrides.

Harbor Fest in Boothbay Harbor

offers a glowing showcase of all local industries in the region. From its three-day tasting event, the Fishin' for Fashion show, and the street fair atmosphere, this late-summer waterfront fun is not to be missed.

Be sure to bundle up to for Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens' **Gardens Aglow**. New England's biggest and brightest light display runs from late November through the end of the calendar year and features more than 650,000 lights! Spend some time before and after your visit to the gardens to enjoy the Boothbay **Festival of Lights**.

The Damariscotta Region is a runner's paradise, with multiple fun runs and road races throughout the year. If you're looking for a challenge, be sure to sign up for the **Waldoboro Day 5K**, the only road race in the state featuring Waldoboro hills and a mid-race whoopee pie. Need a run to get you in the holiday spirit? The town also hosts the **Icy Elf 5K** in December featuring runners donning their most festive attire.

When it comes to festivals, Damariscotta has cornered the market. **The Pemaquid Oyster Festival** in September shucks more than 10,000 oysters to benefit the Edward A. Myers Marine Conservation Fund each year. In October, ginormous gourds flood the streets for **Pumpkinfest**. The holiday season kicks off with the **Villages of Light** celebration, featuring the Parade of Lights and Santa's arrival, in late November.

Around the holidays, enjoy the **Jake Day panoramas** in the windows of Milling Around Antiques & Gifts. The handiwork of this beloved local artist becomes truly magical when viewed after dark. Enjoy this complimentary Christmas treasure!

Bristol's rich history lends itself to a multitude of events and happenings on the Pemaquid Peninsula. The annual **Olde Bristol Days** celebration each August draws the community together with a weekend filled with lobster boat races, vintage car shows, a chicken barbecue dinner, and so much more.

The Damariscotta River

The Midcoast region of Maine boasts a truly unique geography formed during the ice age and visible in the dramatic and beautiful rocky coastline, mountains, valleys and numerous offshore islands of the area. This diverse and charming landscape draws visitors year after year who return for a slice of scenic heaven and the peace and tranquility that coastal towns on the **Gulf of Maine** offer. Part of what makes this region so special is the **Damariscotta River** itself. A 19-mile long tidal river, the Damariscotta (old Abenaki for “river of many fishes”) begins at the outlet of Damariscotta Lake in Damariscotta Mills, emptying into the Damariscotta River. Further evidence of Damariscotta’s close connection to First Nation Americans, including the Abenaki, can be found at the **Whaleback Shell Midden**, a Maine historic site where 1,000 years of discarded oyster shells from 200 BC to AD 1000 can be seen along the riverbanks.

Known worldwide as a unique source for **oysters**, mussels and other developing aquaculture, the River offers undeniable beauty in addition

to its edible bounty, providing a continual pulse within our area. More than 80% of Maine oysters are farmed on the river, and the region offers a rich array of restaurants featuring a variety of shellfish, including mussels and clams. Bring your appetite!

River Cruises are not to be missed, showcasing the fully navigable river in all its glory. Sunset is a particularly beautiful time to board an excursion and possibly see harbor seals, osprey and bald eagles.

Shortly after Damariscotta Mills was settled in 1729, a saw mill was built at the head of the falls between fresh

water Damariscotta Lake and the tidal headwaters of the Damariscotta River. Local alewives, sea-run fish that are members of the herring family, spend most of their lives at sea but return each May and June to spawn in Damariscotta Lake. A “new stream” or **Fish Ladder** was built in 1807 and is functional to this day allowing passage of the alewives each year. A festival celebrating the alewife migration is celebrated each year on Memorial Day Weekend, where the fish can be seen in action, making their way up the fish ladder.

Local Art and Culture

The list of famous artists who have been drawn to the Maine Coast is long, and it's no wonder. Most people who visit once begin planning their next visit before they leave, and sometimes the return is permanent! The area is beautiful in all seasons and the drama of our coastal landscape strikes the artist in all of us. The Damariscotta-Newcastle region is filled with several galleries and creative sources to appreciate art and even inspire yourself. Art supplies are available at Salt Bay Art Supply and several artist-owned galleries and antique shops are located on Bristol Road, just a short distance away from the village. The downtown Damariscotta area features both traditional fine art and photographic art galleries as well as shops devoted exclusively to craft and craft making, including woodcraft and fiber arts supplies, fabric, beads, and pottery. There is no shortage of sources for making your own masterpiece or taking one home!

The **Damariscotta-Newcastle ArtWalk** takes place on the third Friday of each

month June through September. This free, self-guided walking/driving tour is a great way to see art in our area in a fun and celebratory way, and meet our fantastic local artists in person.

Entertainment abounds in this area, and we are lucky to have diverse and ever-changing access to many cultural events. Several choral and musical ensembles call this area home, including the DaPonte String Quartet, Tapestry Singers, St. Cecilia Chamber Choir, Lincoln County Community Theater, and the Heartwood Regional Theater Company. The historic Lincoln Theater offers movies, live performances and live simulcast concert, opera and film showings all year long, featuring The Metropolitan Opera, world-renowned ballet companies like the Bolshoi and New York City Ballet and the Royal Theatre.

Bibliophiles will be pleased to find a book shop with a bustling café and the Skidompha Library right on Main Street. Don't miss Skidompha's Secondhand Book shop for even more take-home treasures!
